District Supplemental Education Services

Transition Plan for 2016-17

May 6, 2016

In December, 2015, President Obama signed the Every Student Succeeds Act, which reauthorized Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1995 (also known as No Child Left Behind). As a result of this reauthorization, some of the regulations changed what services and supports are going to be required for 2016-17 and beyond. One of these was the elimination of Supplemental Education Services (tutoring) and School of Choice as part of the Title I, Part A Program. However, for the 2016-17 school year, districts are required to post their plan for how they will be transitioning from Supplemental Education Services and School of Choice toward other supporting programs and services.

The Oroville Union High School District, as part of its engagement with stakeholders for its Local Control Accountability Plan, determined that supplemental services are still valuable for students and will be made available on all campuses. The components of those services, available at Oroville and Las Plumas High Schools and Prospect Continuation High School are listed below, along with the amount of funds being allocated for those services.

1. Summer School	\$50,000
2. Extended Library Hours	\$1,800
3. Learning Center at PHS	\$43,400
4. Teacher Tutor at OHS/LPHS	\$9,000
5. Para-Educator Tutor at OHS/LPHS	\$4,500
